

Elements of Comics

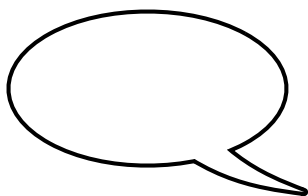
- ✓ In comics some characters do not age over time.
- ✓ Some comics are written as a series.
- ✓ What is said is written in “bubbles” pointing to the characters.



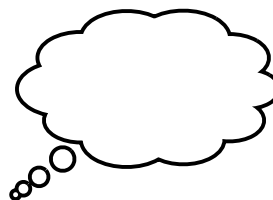
1. Direction. Find a panel where a speech bubble on the left is read before a speech bubble on the right.

2. Bubbles. Find an example of:

a speech bubble



and a thought bubble



3. Caption. Find an example where a caption is used.

4. Voices. Find an example where tone of voice is shown through word shape, bold, or italics.

5. Visual. Find an example where pictures (objects or background) are important for the story.

6. Onomatopoeia. Find an example where sound effects are conveyed by use of a sound word (*e.g., boom, bang*).
