

## Theme in “Peak” by Roland Smith

Using a Popplet, interpret one of the major themes in the novel.

In the Graphic Organizer:

Use **at least** three sections of the story (examples from) to help you explain the theme.

Mention your opinion on the events and theme.

Don't just think about Peak and the theme, but also about the minor characters.

Organize using color and separate bubbles to ensure your ideas on theme are clear and easy to understand.
